Current Healthcare Landscape in India

Challenges

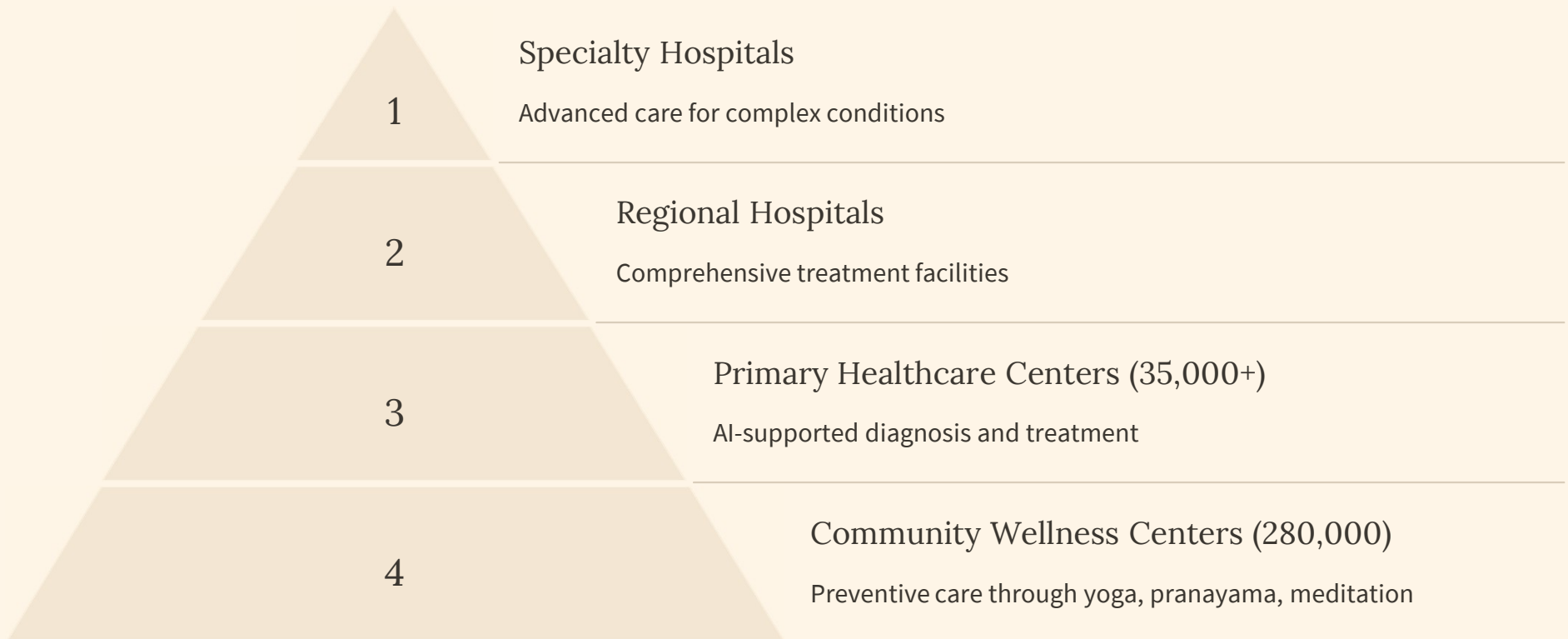
- High-cost curative model unaffordable for most citizens
- Central Government healthcare budget allocation increased to ₹1 lakh crores in 2025-26
- Out-of-pocket expenditure still at 39% of total health expenditure. Possibly higher if unreported spending and unaccounted corruption for providing services are added.

Opportunity

As India moves from the 4th to 3rd largest economy in the next 3 years, Dharma Rajya offers a distinctive economic moat through holistic healthcare that:

- Delivers higher happiness per unit of GDP
- Costs less than conventional approaches
- Positions India as "Viswa Bandhu"

The Preventive Healthcare Pyramid



A ground-up approach prioritizing prevention over expensive treatment, with each level supporting the one above it

Community Wellness Centers: The Foundation

Key Features

- One center per 5,000 citizens
- Located in existing infrastructure where possible (schools, Panchayats)
- Daily yoga, pranayama, and meditation programs
- Nutrition guidance with organic food availability for purchase
- Community-based lifestyle modification support



Integrative Treatment Approach

Allopathy

For acute conditions, infectious diseases, and childhood immunizations

Naturopathy

Natural healing through lifestyle, diet, and natural therapies



Ayurveda

For chronic conditions, constitutional improvement, and preventive care

Homeopathy

For chronic conditions with minimal side effects

Siddha

Traditional Tamil system focusing on balance of elements

Implementation Costs: Community Wellness Centers

Initial setup average cost per center	₹1,870,000
Annual maintenance per center	₹1,000,000
Total centers (1 per 5,000 people) 175,000 in operation now	280,000
Additional capital expenditure	₹23,400 crore+
Annual operational expenditure	₹28,000 crore+

Based on population of 1.4 billion and cost estimates from similar government wellness initiatives including the comprehensive Gujarat implementation . Infrastructure and maintenance costs adjusted to approximate market rates per center on average.

Tiered Healthcare Access Framework

1

Universal Preventive Care

Free access to all Community Wellness Centers and preventive programs regardless of income with built in incentives for participation

2

Lifestyle-Based Entitlements

Additional benefits for citizens who participate in preventive programs and maintain healthy lifestyle metrics

3

Income-Based Treatment Coverage

Tiered payment structure for advanced treatments based on income level, with full coverage for those below poverty line adjusted to prior wellness program participation credits and healthy lifestyle metrics

4

Competitive Public-Private Integration

Government institutions competing with private providers including nonprofits to maintain quality while controlling costs

Path Forward: Dharma Raja Healthcare Vision

Next Steps

1. Pilot 1,000 Community Wellness Centers in diverse settings
2. Develop AI-supported diagnostic systems for Primary Healthcare Centers
3. Create certification programs for yoga and Ayurvedic practitioners
4. Establish organic food supply chains linked to wellness centers
5. Implement lifestyle-based incentive systems with measurable metrics
